

<u>Rookie Cookie Award</u>: Horse and rider in the first year of showing. Recipient to be determined by the Board.

<u>Best Attendance Award:</u> It is awarded to the member who attended the most of the Society recognized shows on any horse at any level. If there shall be ties, the highest average of all rides is the Champion, second highest Reserve Champion, the third highest receives Honorable Mention.


